The pool was never opened this year, so no immediate work needs to be done. She will pursue other contractors over the winter months to set up repairs for next spring.
- 2.**Recreation Center rentals**: D. Whitaker reports that Supervisor Walsh would like to resume limited rentals of the Rec Center, proposing club meetings first, then other events with no more than 50 attendees. Issues include: mandatory lists of attendees for potential future contact tracing, possible temperature check stations, appropriate cleaning of the facility, enforcement of occupancy limits, and ensuring air quality. D. Whitaker will be available for some of these duties. The group discussed air quality/filtration issues and some possible sources for assistance.
