The meeting was called to order at 7:20 pm.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. **Approval of prior minutes:** C. Joseph requested a small change in wording on one item and moved that the so-revised minutes from the January 2026 meeting be approved. Seconded by L. Jerkowski. All in favor.

2. **Shade structure for pool:** D. Whitaker reported that the pool engineers have told her that there are electric wires and pipes underground throughout the pool area and that they advise against any digging in the area. This will make a permanent shade structure impossible. K. Carr reports that the Supervisor has suggested a retractable awning attached to the bathhouse. Estimates will be obtained in the spring.

3. **Proposal for Entertainment:** Amanda Wylie submitted a formal written proposal for a ticket-based event “Chosen Family Feud, a parody of the popular television show. After reviewing the details, the Commission decided that an event of this nature is beyond our purview, and that a municipal facility such as ours is not an appropriate venue for a commercial venture such as this.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Programming Update:** K. Carr reviewed the upcoming Spring schedule. The last scheduled Game Night is March 27. There were no volunteers for an additional night. Watercolor and Improv Classes are ready to begin in March, and the annual Plant Swap is confirmed for March 22. The Book Swap is scheduled for April 19, times TBD. The Yoga teacher anticipates needing several weeks off due to family issues; Supervisor Walsh will not authorize the hiring of any teacher substitutes.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm. The next meeting will be March 18, 2026.
