

LEGAL NOTICE

SPECIAL MEETING OF ROSENDALE LIBRARY DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special District Referendum Vote of the qualified voters of the Rosendale Library District will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, between the hours of 12 noon and 8:00 P.M. at the Rosendale Library, 264 Main Street, Town of Rosendale, County of Ulster, New York, the designated polling place, for the following purposes:

To consider and vote upon an expenditure of funds to support the renovation and expansion of the Library in the form of the following proposition:

Shall the Following Resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Rosendale Public Library is hereby authorized to construct a new library building addition to the public library building operated by said Board of Trustees, with the principal address of 264 Main Street, in Rosendale, New York, including original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, site work and other incidental improvements and costs incidental thereto, at a maximum estimated cost of \$1,950,000, that the Town of Rosendale is hereby authorized to issue obligations in the amount of not to exceed \$1,950,000 (together with renewals thereof) or as much thereof as may be necessary therefor and for which said Library District is hereby authorized to raise by the levy of a tax upon the taxable real property of said Library District and collected in annual installments, such amount as is necessary annually to pay principal, and interest, on such obligations, but in no event an annual amount greater than \$136,000 to pay such annual debt service?

SEQRA STATUS OF PROJECT: The Library Board of Trustees is acting as lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations (collectively "SEQRA"). The library has been determined to be a Type II action, pursuant to SEQRA, for which no further environmental review is necessary.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Special District Referendum Vote shall be conducted by voting on the propositions by paper ballots.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots for the Annual District Vote may be applied for at the office of the Director of the Rosendale Library. Such application must be received at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. The Board of Trustees shall make a list of all persons to whom absentee voter ballots have been issued and have it available during regular office hours commencing May 29, 2026 and until the day of election. Such list will be posted at the polling place during the election. No absentee voter ballot shall be canvassed unless it is received not later than 5:00 P.M. on the day of the Election.
