The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. **Approval of meeting minutes:** R. Sorge moved to approve the minutes from the May 2026 meeting. Seconded by L. Jerkowski. All in favor.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Programming:** K. Carr reported that there are no new Rec Center programs for the summer as the Pool will have an active aquatics program. She presented a proposal from a woman who would like to teach an exercise for adults twice weekly. There was some reservation that attendance for such a program would be low; however the proposal was short on details and the Commissioners would like to know more. It was also suggested that the teacher could run classes at the Circuit Court. K. Carr will discuss with Supervisor Walsh and then respond to the teacher.

2. **Point of Process:** C. Joseph shared a draft letter she plans to send to the Town Supervisors. She has concerns about the process regarding the refurbishment of Veterans Park last year. The Recreation Commission was advised of the project after it was approved by the Town Board, raising questions about responsibility of stewardship of the Park. In addition, she objects that the Commission was not advised that part of the arrangement was the erection of a sign naming the landscaping company which she believes amounts to an advertisement on public property.

3. **Pool update:** D. Whitaker reported that extensive cracks in the pool have been repaired. The pools are now being filled and opening date is likely to be June 27. Staffing is complete. Programming is identical to last year. Swim lessons are very popular, with long waiting lists already.
